



Some Recent Praise Report

Guatemala: This was a huge blessing and success. The Lord really blessed us with His presence at this conference. After speaking 11 times, I had the privilege of going on a radio-talk show with a listening audience of 2.5 million people.



Canada: At the first session, over 20 percent of the ladies accepted Christ into their life or rededicated their life to Christ. During the third session, between 80-90 ladies stood to be totally yielded to God! Praise God – may all glory go to Him.



California: This was probably the most memorable retreat for this season. It would take an entire page to summarize the wonders and works the Lord did that weekend! Well over half of the ladies stated they wanted to be totally committed to God.



Iowa: This retreat was rich as well! The two left pictures show the two sections of the conference room and the right photograph captures all of the ladies gathered for a meal. These ladies have such huge hearts for God and the response was typical: Over 10% of the women accepted the Lord for the first time and almost 50% made a commitment to be wholly as well as "holy" set apart for God.



California: This beautiful sight could be seen from the dining room window. This conference center just started a women's spring retreat and it was well attended. The Lord was so good and work/moved in the lives and hearts of the women. First time commitments were made as well as those yielding everything in their life to God.



Colorado: 150 women gathered for this event. 15 accepted Christ for the first time and 48 stood to say they wanted to yield every room in their heart to God. One-on-one counseling took place late into the night. One-on-one prayer for physical healing and for freedom from addictions also took place.

California: Approximately 150 women gathered for a delicious tea-luncheon. 5 women accepted the Lord for the first time and 13 rededicated their lives. Blessed be the name of the Lord. He is faithful! (Sorry, no photo available.)



Oregon: New material was written for the four sessions. It was a success. On Saturday evening the women heard that Jesus is the light of the world. Each woman held a lit candle and then silently left the center symbolically declaring they were taking The Light into *their* world. Many accepted Christ for the first time and nearly half of the 450 attending women stood to say they wanted to be totally sold-out to God for the first time.

Canada, Multi-Cultural Event: I think I left a part of my heart in Canada. These women, the majority of them born outside of Canada, were from various continents of the world with one bond: Jesus! Many women worked behind the scenes to make this day so wonderful. A woman shared with me that her ex-husband accepted the Lord as he lay dying because of a personal story I shared at the retreat in February.



Canada: As we drove up to the church on Sunday morning a young girl sat on the church steps shooting drugs into her arm. It was a visual reminder how desperately the world needs Jesus. This inner-city church listened attentively and 6 responded to the message. Please continue to pray for those that came forward for salvation and healing.
